

Eight Specific Therapeutic Area ALMs

If you need maximum points or have not obtained the compulsory Category 1 points for the year then you should consider doing an Active Learning Module (ALM) - 30 Category 1 points available.

The 2005 - 2007 triennium requires GPs to earn 130 CPD points of which 60 are compulsory Category 1 points and the remainder Category 2 points. The GPCE ALM program will give you the opportunity to gain 30 Category 1 points over the three days of GPCE. There are eight streams for you to choose from and these are listed in the table below. Select the ALM stream and tick the appropriate box and corresponding sessions on the registration form on page 10. You will need to read some pre-disposing material, (details will be sent to you) and complete a short evaluation of the ALM attended.



Eight Active Learning Modules (ALM)

Delegates must attend six sessions in total from your chosen stream. Four sessions in an ALM stream must be workshops.
